

UGBOROUGH PARISH COUNCIL MEETING Wednesday 4th March 2020 at 7.30pm

Questions from the Public

The applicant of Planning application 0605/20/HHO (Item 20.037.3) presented his proposals

SHDC Cllr Abbott detailed meetings he had attended, including Extinction Rebellion in Ivybridge. The bus sign at David's Lane had been displaced, although the bus stop was still used. Fly tipping near Skew Bridge still needed to be cleared, which he and Cllr Holway would follow up.

SHDC Cllr Holway reported that SHDC was taking a sensible approach to Coronavirus. It was looking at its carbon footprint. A request had been received that the proposed roundabout on the B3213 in Ivybridge should make provision for cyclists, but the cost implications were high as outline planning permission had already been granted.

DCC Cllr Hosking reported that:

- DCC had approved its budget, as detailed at the April Parish Council Meeting, with a Band D Council Tax being £1439.46. The Government had required £21m debt should be held in relation to special education and disability, and this debt was likely to increase.
- The Devon Carbon Plan was progressing, with £250k funding from DCC. Once the Plan was prepared, it would be considered by a citizens assembly, followed by public consultation.
- The 20mph speed test in Ugborough had met the 85th percentile criteria, and Cllr Hosking would be requesting a 20mph speed limit, although enforcement may be a problem. An item on the speed limit would be included on the Annual Parish Meeting agenda and the proposed petition would be deferred.
- The Ware Hill culvert had been completed and the remaining works were progressing. Local businesses who had lost trade due to the road closure could claim compensation. The Safer Road Fund works at the Ware Hill junction were being undertaken at the same time, with resurfacing later.
- Cllr Hosking hoped that works would start soon to slow traffic approaching the junction at Ludbrook
- Workhouse Brook was now draining well, thanks to the work of the Lengthsman.
